- i. You are to write from **HER perspective only**, what **SHE** has done and what happened **TO HER** respectively what was done **TO HER**.*
- ii. Write (very) **short sentences**, not an essay but like notes you can tick off ✓ in a presentation including one element at a time.*
- iii. Do not guess and do not write from memory but **be precise and concise**.
- iv. Do not overdo it (not every single little details is necessary) but avoid being shallow and negligent.
- v. **Do not interpret** and try to avoid the interpretations of the Birlings and Gerald Croft.
- vi. You may want a note for yourself (in brackets) who gave the fact. [G.]

* Example

- **EVA** Smith was born on 1st April 1892.
- **SHE** was abandoned by her mother when **THE GIRL** was 5 years old and (**SHE**) was raised in different foster families.
- **SHE** is said to have been a kind and cheerful young person.
- When **SHE** was 16 years old she made an apprenticeship with Brown&Company.
- **EVA** seems¹⁾ to have done well since two years later she ... ¹⁾

¹⁾ This assumption may be ok when you fell it is really important to mention but the narrating person (the Birlings, Gerald Croft or the inspector) himself is not 100 per cent sure.
